### Interpretation and Definitions

The words in which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or plural.

For this Cookie Notice:

"Company" (referred to as either "Gemsread", "We", "Us", or "Our" in this Cookie Notice) refers to Gemsread Limited [4, Ayodele Obisanaya Crescent, Alagbaka GRA, Akure, Ondo, Nigeria.]

"Cookies" means small files that are placed on your computer, mobile device, or any other device by a website, containing details of your browsing history on that website among its many uses.

"Website" refers to Gemsread's Website accessible [here](#).

"You" means the individual accessing or using the Website.

### What are Cookies?

A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.

Cookies may be either "persistent" cookies or "session" cookies: a persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date unless deleted by the user before the expiry date; a session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed.

Cookies may not contain any information that personally identifies a user, but personal data that We store about You may be linked to the information stored in and obtained from cookies.
